Login with **User name** and **password** you have set during your registration for the event.

Features of the virtual platform

- Access to the **live programme** with links to each lecture
- Direct **contact** to speakers, participants, sponsors and exhibitors
- Sponsors and exhibitors present their company with **virtual exhibition booths**
- **Posters** are accessible as e-posters (PDF) with **individual ways of interaction with the authors**
- Meeting with your peers for **networking** and discussion is possible via “Wonder.me” during coffee and lunch breaks. On day 2 we provide an evening get together via “Zoom”.

Tip: Refresh the website occasionally (Ctrl & R) if you were in-active for a while

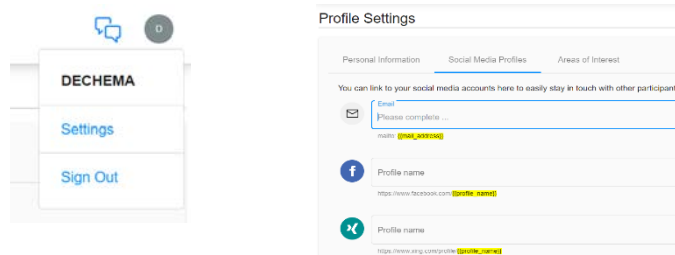
Your virtual profile

Please complete your **personal profile**. This is very helpful for the interaction with the other participants (e.g. with same areas of scientific interest).

You will be asked to complete the profile when you enter the event platform for the first time. At any time, you can find and update your profile settings in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

In order to be contacted by email (via your standard email system), please **actively add your email address** in the profile settings.

You are also welcome to add further social media profiles (**Profile > Settings > Social Media Profiles**) and your areas of interest.



Lectures as live streams

To **access the lectures**, please click on the respective session. The lectures are visible as a live stream; volume control and full-screen mode settings are possible within this window.

Please use the Q&A tool for questions to the speakers:

Q&A: Please click on the current lecture title next to the live stream window to obtain the **question & answer area** associated with the lecture (Q&A area opens below the live stream window).

Please **write your questions in this Q&A area** at any time during the lecture. Your questions will be sent to the moderator of the session for the subsequent discussion.

Discussion with all session speakers will take place at the **end of each session**.

For a more **general exchange** with other participants within the session you may use the **session chat** (clicking on a sessions, a chat function to the right of the streaming window is provided).

Poster Presentation

All posters are accessible for the whole duration of the conference. The authors will be around during the **poster session** on Tuesday, **11 May 2021, 14:00 – 15:25**.

The poster authors may offer **an individual web meeting room** for discussions, hosted by themselves. Access to the web rooms will be indicated in the Q&A area below the posters – please copy and insert the link in the address field of your browser.

Furthermore, you may contact the authors any time via chat or one of the other contact options.

Virtual Exhibition

The exhibition is a showcase for innovative products and services.

At the virtual stands the exhibitors provide a broad range of information and representatives will answer your questions.

Networking opportunities

Contact other participants directly

If you wish to contact a participant individually, click on the name in the list of participants. A small green dot shows who is presently online. A window with different communication options will open:

- **"Meet now"** button: If the person you wish to contact is currently online, you can ask him/her directly for a 1:1 meeting with microphone and video camera. If both sides agree the meeting, the browser-based software „BigBlueButton“ will open automatically to start the 1:1 web meeting.
- **"Send message"** button: you directly enter a chat. You will find your incoming messages in the **chat lobby** at the top, right next to your profile. **Tip:** As you will not receive a signal, we recommend to check your chat lobby regularly.

In **each coffee** and **lunch break** you will have the option to get in touch with other participants via „**Wonder.me**“. Just click on the respective break title in the programme and the link will forward you to the „Wonder“ room. „Wonder“ is a browser-based software, you do not have to download or install any application.
